Benchmark Update - England KS4

Key Stage 4, all qualifications

Updated 2020/21 benchmarks for GCSEs and Level 1/2 BTEC and Cambridge Nationals will be in Connect Interactive from Results Day. We have created the new benchmarks from the full national dataset supplied annually by the Department for Education.

The purpose of this short briefing paper is to provide some headline information about the new Minimum Expected Grades that have been generated from these new benchmarks.


Headline changes:

Minimum Expected Grades (MEGs) for End of Year 2020 and Monitoring 2020/21

The headline news for all qualifications is that where we have re-benchmarked, there is little change in the Expected Points for each prior attainment band, which has meant little or no change in the Minimum Expected Grades (MEGs) for each band or relative band.

This means that if you have been monitoring your current Year 11 students across the year, your progress indicators should remain very similar and allow you to review your Centre Assessed Grades against your Calculated Results in August.

There are some minor changes to the MEGs for both L1/2 Cambridge Nationals and BTECs.

Key Stage 4 MEGs 2019/20

Table 1 shows the updated MEGs and points that will be used for the End of Year Report and Connect Interactive analysis of the Calculated Grade outcomes for Summer 2020. These MEGs and points will be used in Connect Interactive for monitoring across 2020/21. The final column is the comparison with the 2019 MEGs. There are no changes to the MEGs

Main changes to note:

- 1. GCSE MEGs for top prior attainment band have increased to 9/8 (9-8 for Double Award) to reflect greater aspiration.
- 2. Band 10 in the Cambridge National MEGs has dropped from D1 to M1
- 3. For BTEC prior attainment bands 6 & 7 the MEGs have dropped to M/P rather than M in 2019.
